Supply List:

Pattern: Jelly Roll Rug, R.J. Designs*

Fabric: Jelly Roll of your choosing (40, 2 1/2" strips) or you can cut your own.*

Batting: 2 rolls of Bosal White Katadhin 2 1/2" strips of batting.* Or you can cut your own 2 1/2" strips from your own batting. You will need strips that equal approximately 1700" in length. (approximately 1 1/2 yards of 90" batting)

Batting Seam Tape.* This is a fusible product that allows you to fuse the ends of your batting together.

Needles: Size 14 – 18 Jeans needle.* You must use this larger, heavier needle. Other needles will not work.

Thread to match/blend with your chosen fabrics.* You will need approximately 1200 yards, so you will probably need 2 – 3 spools of 50 wt cotton thread.

General sewing supplies: scissors*, straight pins*, seam ripper*, rotary cutter*, small rulers* and mat*, etc.

Binding clips, such as Clover Wonder clips*. This is optional, but I found them to be very useful.

Starch. Either spray starch or Mary Ellen's Best Press*. You must have one of these for the second class.

We will be making the coil of batting and fabric in the first class, so if you are cutting your own fabric and/or batting, please have it all cut into 2 1/2” strips before class.

The second class will be zig-zagging the coil into a rug.

You must have a sewing machine in good working order*. Please make sure it is serviced or clean of lint. Also, a small travel machine may not be strong enough to go through all the layers. So if you have a bigger, stronger machine you will want to use it.
