Supply List:

*Machine in good working order with power cord, foot pedal, $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and instruction manual

*Rotary cutter with new blade and cutting mat

*45 degree triangle ruler and a straight ruler

*Marti Mitchell Magic Mirror – not mandatory but extremely helpful for previewing fabric

*Fabric will be determined by how large a quilt you wish to make and the lengthwise repeat of the fabric. The design is an octagon and requires eight repeats of the design. The blocks are 10" finished. They have 2" corners of two different fabrics alternating for each block. The sashing is 1-1/2" and the cornerstones are 1-1/2" squares. The first class will be a 2 hour discussion and demo of the technique and how to determine the right type of fabric. There will be a handout

to help you purchase the amount of fabric you will need. No machine will be needed for the first class. The display quilt is 57" x 57" and used 6 yards of main fabric, a 1 yard for sashings and a half yard each for the corner adjoining squares and cornerstones. The quilt can be made as large or small as you like.
