

Favorite Sewing Props and Tools

- Extra Bobbins** – keep in a case, some with leftover thread ready to dispatch of.
- Machine Needles** – Keep on hand many sizes & styles needed for your sewing style.
- Large Scissors** – Havel's Serrated 8 1/2 blade do the trick for me.
- Pin Picker Upper** - I LOVE my telescoping and lighted version....makes the task of finding them rouge pins a breeze.
- #2 Pencil** – my favorite fabric making device – it does come out in my wash!
- Rotary Cutter** – my favorite is Quilter's Select
- Pin Cushion** – Handmade pincushions always work the best!! Just kidding but why not make yourself one, or two!
- Professional Tool Turner** - so many reasons to have this tool. One of those reasons is that when I hold it, I become a professional!
- Best Press** – hands down my favorite spray to wrangle wrinkles
- Measuring Tape** – I like mine extra long - 120 Inches - So I can go across my large sewn items with ease..
- Double Sided Cleaning Brush** – Can never overstate the importance of a clean bobbin case and area inside your sewing machine.
- Spool Cap** – I use mine Larger for the troublesome spools of thread & the tiny one as well for embroidery threads. I use all 3 of mine, all the time.
- White Chalk Marking Tools** – Chaco's or General's always on hand for all my dark fabric marking needs.

- Screwdriver** – I like my little stubby ones.
- Hand Sewing Needles** – Buttons, eyes and some seams need special attention.
- Needle Threader** – Hand Sewing, well, my hands have not been upgraded to the newest update featuring an automatic lighted Needle Threader. Until then I will use whatever help I can get from a tool.
- [Wonder Clips](#) – Clips are perfect when pinning is not an option.
- [Hemostats](#) – Pull, grab & hold onto. Yup, these are the tools for that.
- [Seam Ripper](#) – “Jack the Ripper” or “The Un-Sewer”, I like them sharp and nearby.
- [Sewing Tape](#) – Kimberbell’s Tape my FAVORITE hands down.
- [Add-A-Quarter Ruler](#) – Every time I bind a quilt or Foundation Paper Piece.
- [Fabric Glue Stick](#) – it is a mystery how I got on without this before. Use it all the time.
- Curved Blade Scissors** – Such a nifty pair for cutting shapes and getting close up to snip unwanted threads.
- Finger Press** – when all you need is a little pressure & are short of time for an iron.
- [Magnetic Pin Holder](#) – stocked with Glass tipped or “Cool Pins”
- [Quilting Ruler](#) – Quilter’s Select 6x12, gets the most hands on time from me.
- Color Catcher** – Every time I wash my sewn items to make sure dyes do not migrate.
- Tweezers** – I use to grab threads when they need to be disciplined.
- [BladeSaver](#) – the best for chain piecing.
- Basic Scissors** – Keep them sharp & away from *non-fabric cutting*.
